## Fashion, Jewelry & Accessories

1. **OXDX Clothing** – Diné-owned label based in Tempe, AZ, offering bold, graphic-driven apparel that highlights Indigenous identity and activism.
2. **Ginew** – Ojibwe-owned brand producing small-batch denim and outerwear with Native symbolism and artist collaborations.
3. **Mahota Textiles** – First textile company owned by a Southeastern tribe, producing blankets and accessories with Chickasaw designs.
4. **Copper Canoe Woman** – Features handcrafted jewelry blending traditional Native techniques with contemporary aesthetics.
5. **Woolly Bear Jewelry** – Offers unique, handcrafted earrings and accessories inspired by nature and Indigenous culture.
6. **Sweetgrass Beads** – Etsy shop specializing in beaded jewelry that reflects Native traditions and artistry.

3. **Raven Reads** – Subscription box service delivering books and goods from Indigenous authors and entrepreneurs.
4. **Books and Burrow** – Online bookstore offering a curated selection of literature, home goods, and gifts from Indigenous creators.
5. **Bird Cage Book Store** – Online bookstore specializing in Native American literature and educational materials.
